

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Materials

1 ¼ yards	Blocks - Tan (A)	8500-44
¹ / ₄ yard	Star Flower - Lt. Blue (B)	8502-11
¹ / ₄ yard	Aster Dot - Cream/Red (C)	8505-42
¹ / ₄ yard	Character Toss - Red (D)	8506-88
¹ / ₄ yard	Daisy - Green (E)	8501-66
¹ / ₄ yard	Daisy - Gold (F)	8501-33
¹ / ₄ yard	Bias Plaid - Lt. Blue (G)	8503-11
¹ / ₄ yard	Dot Dash - Brown (H)	8504-38
¹ / ₄ yard	Star Flower - Red (I)	8502-88
$1\frac{1}{4}$ yards	Dot Dash - Red (J)	8504-88
¹ / ₂ yard	Character Toss - Tan (K)	8506-44

You will also need:

• 1 yard of cording or 1" wide ribbon for the drawstring

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Blocks - Tan (A):

• Fussy cut (18) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

- Fussy cut (1) 1 ¹/₂" x 40 ¹/₂" LOF strip.
- Fussy cut (1)6 ¹/₂" x 40 ¹/₂" LOF strip.

From the Star Flower - Lt. Blue (B), cut:

• (2) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (20) 2 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Aster Dot - Cream/Red (C), cut: • (1) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (16) 2 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Character Toss - Red (D), cut: • (2) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (20) 2 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Daisy - Green (E), cut: • (2) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (20) 2 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Daisy - Gold (F), cut: • (2) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (19) 2 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Bias Plaid - Lt. Blue (G), cut: • (1) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (15) 2 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Dot Dash - Brown (H), cut: • (2) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (19) 2 ¹/₂" squares.


From the Star Flower - Red (I), cut: • (2) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (19) 2 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Dot Dash - Red (J), cut:
(1) 29 ¹/₂" x 40 ¹/₂" WOF strip.
(1) 13" diameter circle from template


From the Character Toss - Tan (K), cut: • (1) 13" diameter circle from template

Sewing Instructions

1. Follow Figure 1 and sew (8) assorted $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares together to make (1) Block One. Repeat to make (13) Block Ones total.



2. Follow Figure 2 and sew (6) assorted $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares together to make (1) Block Two. Repeat to make (4) Block Twos total.



Bag Assembly

(Refer to Figure 3 while assembling.)

3. Sew (4) $4\frac{1}{2}$ Fabric A squares and (3) Block Ones together, alternating them, to make Row One. Repeat to make Rows Two and Four.

4. Sew (20) assorted 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares together to make (1) DE strip.

5. Sew (2) Block Twos, (3) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A squares and (2) Block Ones together to make Row Three. Repeat to make Row Five.

6. Sew Row One, (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A strip, (1) DE strip, Row Two, Row Three, Row Four, (1) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A strip and Row Five together in that order to make bag body.

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

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7. Pin the 29 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J strip to the Fabric J circle along the 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ " edge. Adjust the bag body as needed to match the circle diameter. Unpin the bag body panel.

8. Align the 29 $\frac{1}{2}$ edges of the bag body, right sides together. Sew the two sides together to create a tube, leaving a 4" opening for turning.

9. Pin the bottom edge of the tube to the circle, right sides together. Sew the circle to the tube to make the bag lining.

10. Repeat Steps 7-9 with the bag body and the 13" Fabric K circle. Do not leave an opening for turning.

11. Mark two vertical line $\frac{1}{2}$ " long and $\frac{1}{2}$ " apart on the 1" Fabric A strip (Fig. 4). Using your favorite method make a buttonhole on each line to complete the outer bag.



12. Place the bag lining together with the outer bag, right sides together, aligning the top raw edges of each and pin together. Sew the two pieces together. Turn the completed bag right side out through the opening in the lining. Stitch the opening closed.

13. Stitch in the ditch on either side of the 1" Fabric A strip through both the outer bag and lining on the drawn lines to create a drawstring channel around the bag.

14. Thread the drawstring through the channel to complete the bag.
