## Quilt Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

## From the Tuscany Panel - Burgundy (A): <br> Quilt

- Fussy cut (1) $191 / 2>1 \times 221 / 2 "$ panel.


## Place Mats

- Fussy cut (4) $6^{1 / 2 "}$ x $91 / 2 "$ small panels.

From the Scroll - Ecru (B), cut:
Quilt

- (2) $31 / 2 " \times 221 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
- (2) 2 " $\times 25^{1 / 2}$ " WOF strips.
- (2) $11 / 2 " \times 381 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
-(2) $11 / 2 " \times 361 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
-(3) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 2 " \times 431 / 2 "$ strips.
-(2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 411 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
-(8) $21 / 2 " \mathrm{x}$ WOF strips.


## Place Mats

-(4) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (96) $11 / 2 "$ squares.

## From the Scroll - Burgundy (C), cut:

Quilt
-(4) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips.
-(2) 2 " $\times 381 / 2$ " WOF strips.
-(2) 2 " $\times 411 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
-(6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.

## Place Mats

-(2) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (24) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

- (7) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the bindings.

From the Scroll - Aubergine (D), cut:
Quilt
-(3) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips.

From the Scroll - Green (E), cut:
Quilt
-(3) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips.
Place Mats

- (3) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (8) $11 / 2 " x 121 / 2 "$ strips.


## From the Grape Vine - Ecru (F), cut:

Quilt
-(5) $51 / 2 \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $51 / 2 " \times 531 / 2 "$ strips and (2) $5 \frac{1}{1 / 2 "} \times 431 / 2 "$ strips.

## Place Mats

- (1) $101 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (8) $21 / 2 " \times 101 / 2 "$ strips and (8) $21 / 2 " \times 91 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Floral Vine - Aubergine (G), cut:

## Place Mats

- (1) $121 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (4) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 121 / 2$ " strips, (4) $21 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$ strips and (24) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

From the Floral Vine - Ecru (Backing), cut:
Quilt

- (2) $61 "$ x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to $61 " \times 61$ " for the back.


## Place Mats

-(2) 22 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (4) 16 " x 22 " strips for the backs.

## Sewing Instructions <br> Quilt

1. Sew (1) $31 / 2 " \times 221 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the $191 / 2 " \times 221 / 2 "$ Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2" x $251 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the panel to measure $24 \frac{1}{2} / 2$ square to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).

2. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric C strip, (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric B strip and (1) $21 / 2$ " x WOF Fabric E strip together lengthwise and in that order to make (1) CBE strip set (Fig. 2). Repeat to make a second CBE strip set.
3. Cut the CBE strip sets into (20) $21 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 " \mathrm{CBE}$ strips (Fig. 3).

4. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \mathrm{x}$ WOF Fabric B strip, (1) $21 / 2 " \mathrm{x}$ WOF Fabric D strip and (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric B strip together lengthwise and in that order to make (1) BDB strip set (Fig. 4).
5. Cut the BDB strip set into (10) $21 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 " B D B$ strips (Fig. 5).

make 10
6. Sew (2) CBE strips and (1) BDB strip together to make (1) CC block (Fig. 6). Pay attention to the orientation of the strips. Repeat to make (10) CC blocks total.

7. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF Fabric D strip, (1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF Fabric E strip and (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric D strip together lengthwise and in that order to make (1) DED strip set (Fig. 7).
8. Cut the DED strip sets into (10) $21 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ DED strips (Fig. 8).

9. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF Fabric B strip, (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric C strip and (1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF Fabric B strip together lengthwise and in that order to make (1) BCB strip set (Fig. 9). Repeat to make a second BCB strip set.
10. Cut the $B C B$ strip sets into (20) $B C B$ strips (Fig. 10).

11. Sew (2) BCB strips and (1) DED strip together to make (1) BB block (Fig. 11). Repeat to make (10) BB blocks total.

## Page 3

Quilt Top Assembly
(Refer to Figure 12 while assembling the quilt top.) 12. Sew (2) BB blocks and (2) CC blocks together, alternating them, to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of the Center Block. Pay attention to the orientation of the strips.
13. Sew (3) CC blocks and (3) BB blocks together, alternating them, to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block. Pay attention to the orientation of the strips.
14. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 361 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 381 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
15. Sew (1) $2 " \times 381 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x $411 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
16. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 411 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 431 / 2$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
17. Sew (1) $51 / 2 " \times 431 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $51 / 2 " \times 531 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
18. Layer and quilt as desired.
19. Sew the (6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
20. Bind as desired.

## Place Mat Top Assembly

(Refer to Figure 20 while assembling.)
7. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to each side of (1) A block to make (1) EA block. Repeat to make (4) EA blocks total.
8. Sew (3) GG blocks together to make (1) GG strip. Repeat to make (4) GG strips total.
9. Sew (1) GG strip to the left side of (1) EA block to make (1) place mat top. Repeat to make (4) place mat tops total.
10. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip to the left side of (1) place mat top. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric G strip to the right side of the place mat top. Repeat for the remaining (3) place mat tops.
11. Layer and quilt as desired.
12. Sew the (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press. Cut the long strip into (4) equal lengths.
13. Bind as desired.

Fabric B square to the lower right corner of the $21 / 2$ " Fabric G square to make (1) BGB block (Fig. 17).

3. Follow Figure 16 for the seam direction to add a $11 / 2 "$

4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (24) BGB blocks total.
5. Repeat Steps 2-3 using (24) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C squares and (48) $11 / 2 "$ Fabric B squares to make (24) BCB blocks (Fig. 18).
6. Sew (2) BCB blocks and (2) BGB blocks together to make (1) GG block (Fig. 19). Repeat to make (12) GG blocks total.
2. Place (1) $11 / 2 "$ Fabric B square on the top left corner of (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric G square, right sides together (Fig. 14). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 14). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 15). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4$ " away from the sewn seam.
