## Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge.

From the Multi Panel (A), cut:

- Fussy cut (1) panel $1 / 4$ " outside the checkerboard, centered on the boat.
- Fussy cut (8) panels, approximately $41 / 2$ " square, each centered on an animal.

From the Yellow Chevron (B), cut:
-(2) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Note: Measure the length of the panel and cut strips to match.

- (2) $41 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Note: Measure panel with side borders and cut strips to length.
- (2) 2 " $x$ width of fabric (WOF) strips. Sub-cut the strips into (16) 2" x $41 / 2 "$ strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (16) 2 " x $71 / 2$ " strips.


## From the Green Chevron (C), cut:

- (3) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut (2) $11 / 2$ " $\times 481 / 2$ " strips.
- (2) $11 / 2 " \times 381 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Purple Zebras (D), cut:
-(1) $61 / 2 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (5) $61 / 2$ " squares.

From the Blue Fox (E), cut:
-(1) $61 / 2$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (6) $6 \frac{112 "}{}$ " squares.

From the Green Monkey (F), cut:

- (1) $6 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strips into (5) $61 / 2 "$ squares.
-(6) $21 / 2$ " $x$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Blue Tossed Animals (G), cut:
- (6) $31 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut (2) $31 / 2 " \times 501 / 2$ " strips and (2) $31 / 2 " \times 441 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Multi Animal Patch (Backing), cut:

- (2) 52 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 52 " x 64 " back.

## Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 301 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the $221 / 2 " \times 301 / 2 "$ Fabric A panel. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 261 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure $24^{1 / 2 \prime \prime} \times 361 / 2$ " to complete the center block.
2. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 41 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 71 / 2$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric B square. Trim the block to $61 / 2 "$ square to complete (1) Animal Block. Repeat to make (8) Animal Blocks total.

## Quilt Top Assembly <br> Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.

3. Sew (2) $61 / 2 "$ Fabric E squares, (2) Animal Blocks, (1) $61 / 2 "$ Fabric F square and (1) $61 / 2 "$ Fabric D square together to make one strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of the center block.
4. Sew (2) Animal Blocks, (2) $61 / 2$ " Fabric D squares, (1) $61 / 2$ " Fabric E square and (1) $61 / 2$ " Fabric F square together to make (1) strip. Sew this strip to the top of the center block.
5. Sew (2) Animal Blocks, (2) $61 / 2$ " Fabric F squares, (1) $61 / 2 "$ Fabric E square and (1) $61 / 2 "$ Fabric D square together to make (1) strip. Sew this strip to the bottom of the center block to make the quilt top.
6. Sew (1) $11 / 2$ " $\times 481 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 381 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
7. Sew (1) $3^{1 / 2 \prime \prime} \times 50^{1 / 2 \prime}$ " Fabric G strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 441 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
8. Layer and quilt as desired.
9. Sew the (6) $21 / 2$ " x WOF Fabric F strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
10. Bind as desired.
