
# Jingle Pops

# Collection by Hoffman California International Fabric

Finished Quilt Size: 58" x 68"

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#### Fabric Requirements

(2) Packages of Jingle Pops (Pre-cut 2-1/2" Strips)

1 Yard Fabric A M7471-166G Evergreen/Gold (Inner Border & Binding)

7/8 Yard Fabric B M7462-22G Ivory/Gold (Outer Border) 4 Yards M7468-20G Natural/Gold (Backing)

64" x 74" Batting

## General Information

- It is not recommended to pre-wash the pre-cut fabric. Pre-wash and starch the yardage if desired.
- ➤ All seams are sewn with a 1/4" seam allowance.
- ➤ WOF = Width of Fabric Selvage to Selvage
- > Press seams open as much as possible to decrease bulk.
- Finished Blocks are 10" x 10". There are (30) Blocks, (15) Regular and (15) Mirror.
- ➤ Label all pieces when cut for easier construction.
- ➤ When sub-cutting the 2-1/2" strips be very careful when cutting off the selvage to preserve the strip as you will need 42-1/2" from selvage to selvage.

Note: Not all of the strips will be used so this allows for you to have some fun and create a Pillow to go with the Quilt if desired.


#### Instructions

#### Step 1 – Cutting the Fabric


- 1. 2-1/2" Strips Sort into TWO stacks (16) Lights and (38) Darks.
- 2. Sub-cut the Light strips into (270) 2-1/2" squares. Draw a diagonal line onto the WRONG side of (240). Set aside (30) of the 2-1/2" squares for the center of the blocks.
- 3. Pull (14) of the Dark strips and sub-cut into (120) 4-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles Round 1.
- 4. From the remaining (24) Dark strips and sub-cut into (120) 8-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles Round 2.
- 5. Fabric A Cut (7) strips at 1-1/2" x WOF Join all the strips at the 1-1/2" edge then sub-cut into (2) 1-1/2" x 60-1/2" rectangles (Left and Right Sides) and (2) 52-1/2" x 1-1/2" rectangles (Top and Bottom) Inner Border.
- 6. Fabric B Cut (7) strips at 3-1/4" x WOF Join all the strips at the 3-1/4" edge then sub-cut into (2) 3-1/4" x 62-1/2" rectangles (Left and Right Sides) and (2) 58" x 3-1/4" rectangles (Top and Bottom) Outer Border.

Note: This project is sewn in ROUNDS and there are two rounds. You will be sewing them together with Partial Seams (aka: PS). A Partial Seam is when you sew the first edge ½ of the way down the shortest piece, then sew the remaining three edges and go back and finish the first edge.

#### <u>Step 2 – Regular Block</u>

## Round 1

- 7. Layer (1) Light 2-1/2" square onto the left edge of (1) Dark 2-1/2"  $\times$  4-1/2" rectangle and stitch on the drawn line as illustrated in Example B. Trim  $\frac{1}{4}$ " past the seam towards the outside and press to measure 2-1/2"  $\times$  4-1/2" Make (60) Label "Set A".
- 8. Using the illustration of Example A as a guide sew (1) Set A just completed to (1) Light 2-1/2" square with the Light towards the top with a PS to make the lower right edge Make (15).
- 9. Sew (1) Set A to the top right edge all the way across with the light towards the left Make (15).
- 10. Sew (1) Set A to the upper left edge all the way across with the light towards the bottom– Make (15).
- 11. Sew (1) Set A to the lower left edge all the way across with the light towards the right, then finish the PS and to finish Round 1 at 6-1/2" square Label "Center" Make (15).

#### Round 2

Note: Round 2 is prepared and sewn exactly the same way as Round 1.

- 17. Layer (1) Light 2-1/2" square onto the left edge of (1) Dark 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangle and stitch on the drawn line as illustrated in Example B. Trim ¼" past the seam towards the outside and press to measure 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" Make (60) Label "Set B".
- 18. Using the illustration of the Finished Regular Block as a guide, sew (1) of Set B just completed to the right side of the CENTER with the Light towards the top with a PS Make (15).
- 19. Sew (1) Set B to the top right edge all the way across with the light towards the left Make (15).
- 20. Sew (1) Set B to the upper left edge all the way across with the light towards the bottom Make (15).
- 21. Sew (1) Set B to the lower left edge all the way across with the light towards the right, then finish the PS to finish Round 2 and the "Regular Block" at 10-1/2" square Make (15) Label and set aside for use later.

#### Step 3 – Mirror Blocks

- 22. Layer (1) Light 2-1/2" square onto the right edge of (1) Dark 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle and stitch on the drawn line as illustrated in Example D. Trim 1/4" past the seam towards the outside and press to measure 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" Make (60) Label "Set C".
- 23. Using the illustration of Example C as a guide sew (1) Set C just completed to (1) Light 2-1/2" square with the Light towards the bottom with a PS to make the upper right edge Make (15).
- 24. Sew (1) Set C to the bottom right edge all the way across with the light towards the left Make (15).
- 25. Sew (1) Set C to the lower left edge all the way across with the light towards the top Make (15).
- 26. Sew (1) Set C to the upper left edge all the way across with the light towards the right, then finish the PS and to finish Round 1 at 6-1/2" square Label "Center" Make (15).

#### Round 2

Note: Round 2 is prepared and sewn exactly the same way as Round 1.

- 27. Layer (1) Light 2-1/2" square onto the right edge of (1) Dark 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangle and stitch on the drawn line as illustrated in Example D. Trim 1/4" past the seam towards the outside and press to measure 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" Make (60) Label "Set D".
- 28. Using the illustration of the Finished Mirror Block as a guide, sew (1) of Set D just completed to the upper right side of the CENTER with the Light towards the bottom with a PS Make (15).
- 29. Sew (1) Set D to the bottom right edge all the way across with the light towards the left Make (15).
- 30. Sew (1) Set D to the lower left edge all the way across with the light towards the top Make (15).
- 31. Sew (1) Set D to the top left edge all the way across with the light towards the right, then finish the PS to finish Round 2 and the "Mirror Block" at 10-1/2" square Make (15) Label and set aside for use later.

## Step 4 – Sewing the Quilt Top

- 32. Sew (5) blocks together alternating between the Regular and Mirror Blocks as illustrated on the Cover Photo to make (6) rows at 50-1/2" x 10-1/2". Sew the rows together to finish the center of the quilt at 50-1/2" x 60-1/2" as follows:
  - a. Rows 1, 3, and 5: Mirror, Regular, Mirror, Regular, Mirror
  - b. Rows 2, 4, and 6: Regular, Mirror, Regular, Mirror, Regular
- 33. Sew (1) Fabric A 1-1/2"  $\times$  60-1/2" rectangle to the left and right sides, then sew (1) Fabric A 52-1/2"  $\times$  1-1/2" rectangle to the top and bottom to finish the Inner Border at 52-1/2"  $\times$  62-1/2".
- 34. Sew (1) Fabric B 3-1/4"  $\times$  62-1/2" rectangle to the left and right sides, then sew (1) 58"  $\times$  3-1/4" rectangle to the top and bottom to finish the quilt top at 58"  $\times$  68".

# Step 5 – Finishing the Quilt

- 35. Layer the backing, batting, and quilt top and quilt as desired.
- 36. Using Fabric A cut (8) strips at 2-1/2" x WOF Join all the strips together at the 2-1/2" edge then sew on the binding to finish the quilt.
