Fabric and Pincushion Project by Karen Styles of Somerset Patchwork

Fussy-Cut Pincushions

- 1. Choose two VICTORIA PARK prints to fussycut; make sure that there are at least 6 repeats of each design feature within your fabric choice.
- 2. Make a hexagon and diamond template from clear plastic the exact size as the shapes drawn below.
- Place the hexagon template over your fabric choice, look through the plastic and find 6 identical designs, draw around the shape on the wrong side of the fabric and cut out with a ¼" seam allowance.
- 4. Repeat this technique with the diamond shape and cut 12 diamonds to make 2 stars
- 5. Hand stitch the 6 matching diamonds together using a small running stitch to create a star, repeat to make a second star.
- 6. Join hexagons together in a straight line making sure the fussy cut designs all face the same way.
- 7. Attach the stars to the hexagons, leaving one hexagon seam open.
- 8. Stuff the pincushion with fiberfill and ladder stitch the last seam closed.
